

Impartiality Statement

f) The auditor does not accept any gifts, cash gifts, and does not participate in consumer entertainment activities and banquets.

g) Do not engage in product development and commercial activities that affect the fairness of certification.

h) Accept the supervision of certification stakeholders, public opinion and the media, and take the supervision information as an important basis for improving work and standardizing certification behavior.
